Masks Are Required During COVID-19





Masks are required during the full duration of all Safari West tours and other activities.

This helps reduce the risk of contracting the disease from or transmitting it to guests, staff, or animals. Masks must be worn during both the walking and driving portion of any safari tour as well as during any Behind the Scenes or other animal encounter. Masks are also required while inside any building or when within six feet or less of another individual. Please understand that this policy is non-negotiable and instituted for the health and safety of the entire Safari West family. Failure to comply with this policy may result in cancellation of safari tours and other activities.

Safari Tour Truck and Number of Guests

In order to provide the safest experience for guests going on safari with us, we've limited the number of guests per truck, remodeled our trucks to include plastic sheet barriers between each row of bench seats and have embraced stringent cleaning practices. Plus, each bench seat is assigned to individual family members and they are not shared with other guests. With our safety precautions in place, every vehicle may depart with up to 8, maybe 10 guests on board.
